I was able to visit Morgan, Natricia and Mukama (triplets) last week – they are all doing well, drinking cow’s milk to supplement breast milk, and otherwise healthy. Their parents are being assisted by their grandmother, who is also helping with the three older siblings (one seen here on the right with one of the triplets). We would really love to help them build a bigger house, as theirs is a tiny two-roomed hut that is somewhat decrepit. If you would like to assist specifically with this, please contact us.



Last month, after living with us for a couple of weeks, Henery, Juliet and Janet were resettled with their grandmother. They had originally been living with her before some other relatives ‘took’ them. They have been returned to their grandmother, and Amari is helping the children with some basic educational support and food assistance. We are very grateful to those who have contributed to repairing/rebuilding the siblings house.
